Recently produced by film maker Randy Atkins, *Arsenal of Hypocrisy*, investigates the race to use space technology to control the Earth. The video's impact draws intensity from such wide-ranging figures as Werner von Braun, Dwight Eisenhower, Apollo astronaut Edgar Mitchell and Noam Chomsky who talk about the dangers of moving the arms race into space.

The one-hour production features archival footage and Pentagon documents. It clearly outlines U.S. plans to "control and dominate" space and from there, the Earth, with nuclear power.

Mitchell, the 6th man to walk on the moon, warns that a war in space would create massive bits of space junk that would create a mine field surrounding the Earth making it virtually impossible to launch anything into the heavens.

Noam Chomsky talks about how the U.S. intends to use space technology to control the Earth and reminds the viewer that the U.S. refuses to negotiate a global ban on weapons in space.

The video contains archival sound of President Dwight Eisenhower in 1961 warning the American people about the power of the military industrial complex.
