

Mission Accomplished



Seven months after the announced “end” of the war, Sean Langan (Behind the Lines, Travels of a Gringo), armed with just a camera, takes a brave and eventful trip through Iraq, seeking to shed light on what life is like in this newly occupied territory and to make an attempt to shed some light on the reasons for the resistance movement, which didn’t seem to have any name or clear aims. Along with interviewing civilians, Langan joins the US-led coalition on patrol (even at times of attack), as well as instigating secret meetings with the resistance fighters.

Watch this documentary if you really want to know what’s happening in Iraq. It shows both sides of the story about the insurgency war that you won’t see in the mainstream media. While critical of US policy, it is sympathetic to the American soldiers on the ground.
