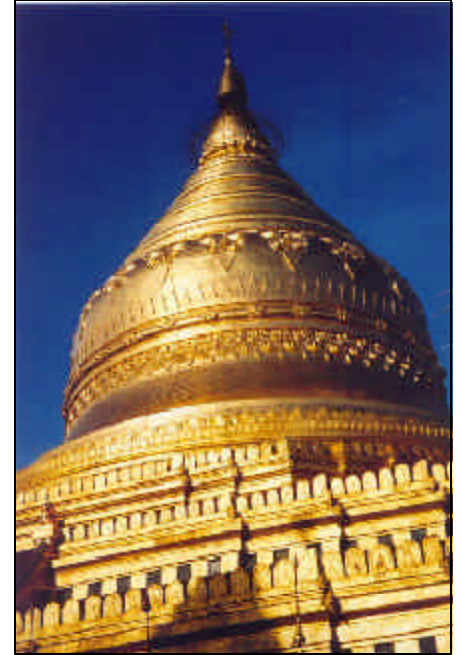


# Burma's Non-Violent Saffron Revolution
