“Peace On Your Wings,” a musical and a movement



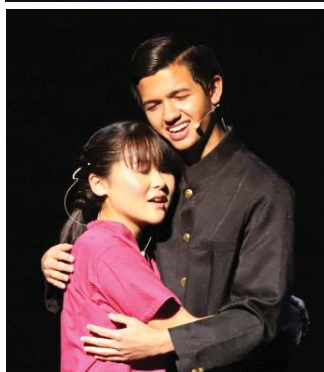
